

Pastor Scott's Corner

It has been a year since the Leadership Team decided to cancel the position of paid Secretary in our Church Office. It was last year on May 12 when we informed Vicki Petsche of that decision. It was the following week then that we began to have volunteers serving Aldersgate in our Office. One year later there are two obvious results of this decision.

One, we have 5 people who serve very well in our office Monday through Friday from 10 to 2. Of course, we can use somebody on Tuesdays, but that's not a lamentation. (If you'd be interested is serving on Tuesdays please talk with Janice Garrett!) These volunteers perform many tasks including typing the weekly bulletin, preparing the prayer requests from Sunday Worship, submitting the sermon titles to the newspaper, filing our needed reports to the Annual Conference, answering the telephone, responding to emails, and being a friendly face in the office. One person is responsible for typing and editing this newsletter, and he does that from his home! These tasks are being done without remuneration and I am very grateful for their work.

The second result of this decision is a savings to Aldersgate in an amount of \$34,000 and then some. This was the main motivation behind the decision, and that decision was not warmly received by everyone. We have lost some people over this last year because of it. But a positive result has been our bank account being in the black since last May. We had fallen behind financially in an amount up to \$23,000 in the past. This cost us the loss of one of our Treasurers. So, it is a boundless joy to know that we have been able to pay our bills, as well as 100% of our Conference Support, which we were unable to do as recently as a year-and-a-half ago. So, I thank you for your continued support of the Mission and Ministry of Aldersgate United Methodist Church through your financial gifts, as well as your prayers, your presence, your service, and your Witness.

And I also want to thank the people that have, and continue to give, of their time so that the office of Aldersgate UMC is functioning. Those people include Janice Garrett (who functions as the Volunteer Coordinator), Cheryl Sharp, Skot Stribolt, Penny Miller, Jeannie Zepp, Shelly Young, and Ken Lind. It also included some who gave their time but decided such work was not for them, or received a job and we lost their help. Those people included Lynn Little, Sheri Stephens, Dick Hiersche, and Lisa Jaross.

All their work has been appreciated and remains so. Therefore, on Sunday June 11th, at our Annual One Service and Barbecue, we are going to take a time to say thank you for these people and the work they have provided! This is not to ignore the other great volunteer work by so many, such as the people who bring goodies on Sunday, those who teach our Bible studies, or who sing in our choir and praise team. It is also not to ignore the many people who serve us as ushers and greeters on Sunday who so warmly welcome us with a smile and a bulletin. It is not to ignore the people who serve on our Committees, and who are always here for a work day, and who count our weekly offerings. All that is greatly appreciated!

We are thanking these volunteers specifically because of the benefit to us financially which is enabling us to be better stewards of the gifts that you, the people of Aldersgate, give us.

On Sunday June 11, if you would like, please feel free to bring a thank you note to give to our volunteers because what they do for us has been invaluable and we want to say thank you all!
