I wanted to write a separate article to share with you the Purpose, Vision, Journey, and Mission statements that were a result of our visioning sessions last year. Here they are:

Aldersgate UMC Mission, Visioning, and Purpose Statements:



Treasurer's report:

Total contributions to the General Fund from monthly giving for the month of February were \$22,992.95, which is slightly overstated due to an annual offering being received meant to cover the entire year. Expenses for February were lower than normal, only totaling \$14,944.77, leaving an ending General Fund balance of \$27,990.23 after paying the conference tithe. That's almost an \$8,000 net increase in the fund balance from the month before.

Thank you for your continued prayers over the finances of the church.



Each week so many challenges are unforeseen to us, from late-night ER trips to extended hospital stays to last-minute trips to Jerusalem. We can't make a schedule for the week and expect it to stay the same, but we can sit at the end of the week and look back to see what God had planned for us, and how much more beautiful our life because of it.



We can focus on our works and disciplines, but that is not how we are sanctified. We are sanctified by following the path of the Messiah. A sheep will not find the pasture by wandering but by walking in the footsteps of the shepherd, and this is true and apparent on every level of life at Shevet. We do not know how our weeks will end, and each day carries surprises. We could not juggle it all; we could not come up with a solution for everything instantly.
