


# **Blessings Aldersgate Church Family**,

Several others brought salads, bread and a delicious cheesecake that was brought by Ruthie Holland. It was prepared for her by the kitchen staff at Sycamore Glen, where she lives.

Chris shared how the Lord drew him into Kairos and how it has been a blessing to work with the prisoners. We later saw a video of a prisoner sharing how God has changed his life through prison ministry and how now he is ministering to his cellmates.

Chris also wants to thank everyone that has supported Kairos by providing cookies, cutting out hands, and signing up to support the prisoners by taking a time on the prayer list.



## **Missions**

Missions night is set for Sunday Oct 8 at 6 PM. There will be a pot-luck meal and a presentation about one of our mission projects by Katherine Parker, who serves with the United Mission to Nepal. She was with us several years ago and gave an excellent presentation about their work: health care, agriculture, education, community transformation and ecology in a region of high mountains north of India.

The United mission is a cooperative mission of several Christian mission organizations, founded 67 years ago. Bob and Hazel Buckner, whose parents were a part of Aldersgate church in the past, served in Napal for 40 years before retiring and serving as pastor of Montague UMC. Our church has a long connection with the mission in Nepal.

Come and meet Katherine and get an update about the fascinating work of what God is doing in this country where it was once forbidden to convert people to Jesus.
