As we prepare for 2024 (it is just a few short weeks away), we will start our Advent study as we look at a series titled God With Us. We will celebrate Advent along with Christmas, and New Years Eve. This year our Christmas Eve service will be at 7pm in the Sanctuary of our church. We'll meet once a month on a Sunday after worship. Once we decide on which Sunday (probably the second or third Sunday), we'll try to consistently meet each month at the same time and let you know when we meet. The meeting is open to anyone who wants to come & present ideas, comment on something happening in our church, or just observe the meeting.

This will be an adjustment as we figure out how to combine the work of the committees into one meeting. In addition, we'll work with pastor Scott on the ideas that came from the vision sessions, and his ideas for involvement in our neighborhood. Your prayer is greatly appreciated (and needed) as we work together in this organizational change and to grow our church.

## Trustees report

This is our last report for the year and for the forseeable future as the Trustees is being combined with several other church boards to create one administrative board to handle affairs of the church. This is in recognition of the reduced membership in the church and the difficulty in finding qualified persons willing to serve on the many boards previously staffed.

The things that have been accomplished are as follows:

- Experts in the Home has been retained to service our heating and air-conditioning systems. They will perform the semiannual maintenance service, once in the spring to assess the air conditioning and once in the fall to assess the heating system before they are needing repair.
- We have also renewed the contract with Sigler Pest Control for the 2024 calendar year.
- It was decided that we would not be able to accommodate Lifeline Screening in the spring as the week they requested is the week before Easter and there is too much going on at that time for us to be breaking down the Sanctuary and resetting it. We may be able to work with them in the fall.
- It is the consensus of the Board that we should dispose of the old green Sanctuary chairs that we have in storage. If you know of anyone wanting the chairs, contact Bryan Graves.

Since this is my last year with the Board of Trustees, I would like to thank everyone that I have served with over the last four years for their cooperation in serving and enriching our church.
